RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Research Focus

My research has several related themes centering around epidemiology, clinical epidemiology, and treatment development for dementia, especially Alzheimer's (AD) and its prodromes.

As of 23 March 2021, my H-index with Google Scholar was 125, with 55,912 citations to my work.

As investigator in the Cache County Study of Memory, Health, and Aging, and the Cardiovascular Health Cognition Study, I led or contributed to studies on the incidence, prevalence, and risk factors for dementia or MCI. These findings are widely cited internationally and have significantly impacted understanding of the epidemiology of dementia and its prodromes. Publication (d) below, demonstrating universal prevalence of neuropsychiatric symptoms (NPS) in dementia, has been cited over 1200 times and is a basis for accelerated efforts to develop effective therapies targeting NPS (more below):

As CoPI/Multiple PI of the Cache County Dementia Progression Study, I led or co-led studies describing the patterns of dementia progression, and associated risk factors, in a unique population-based sample of incident dementia. This work demonstrated great variability in dementia progression after onset, as well as the contribution the care environment, medical co-morbidities, and NPS to accelerated progression. As many of these factors are modifiable this work has greatly contributed to the development of evidence based comprehensive dementia care approaches that can be implemented currently (see below).

In a series of investigations, I studied in depth patterns of occurrence and impact of NPS on dementia or transition from MCI to dementia. In recognition of leadership in this area I was asked by the Alzheimer's Association to lead an international work group on NPS treatment development that continues work as the NPS-Professional Interest Area of ISTAART. This group proposed a specific set of NPS syndromes laying the foundation for accelerated efforts to develop therapies targeting each of these. This approach has gained wide traction with pharmaceutical companies internationally, and with regulatory agencies such as FDA.

In recent years, my work has focused on accelerating treatment development for MCI or dementia due to Alzheimer's. Subthemes have included development of novel imaging and blood biomarkers to facilitate clinical trials, and as PI or CoPI of a series of NIH-funded R01 or U01s, testing novel therapies such as NSAIDs for the prevention of AD, sertraline for depression, citalopram for agitation, deep brain stimulation for mild AD dementia, or comprehensive dementia care (MIND at HOME) to delay the transition from community homes to institutions. In the latter efforts, I developed extensive skills and experiences as the national PI of several multi-center clinical trials solidifying my expertise as an interventional epidemiologist. Most recently I was awarded a \$15m grant by NIA to develop novel, personalized algorithms for the treatment of NPS-agitation in a multicenter clinical trial.
