## **Text Diploma Thesis**

1. Page numbering should be in Arabic numerals (e.g 1,2,3,4, etc.) and should be shown at the center of the bottom of the page. The number of page
2. Font size 12. Proposed fonts: Helvetica, Arial or Times New Roman or Calibri.
3. Line spacing: 1.5.
4. Page margins: 2.5 cm (top-bottom and left-right).
5. The pages should be right- and left-justified.
6. The citation of the References within the text can be shown in two formats, as numbers or the names of the authors. If the number system is chosen, one can follow (a) numbers as superscripts after the period (e.g The actions of cannabinoids are mediated by cannabinoid receptors.<sup>1,3,5</sup>) or b) with numbers in square brackets before the dot (e.g. The actions of cannabinoids are mediated by cannabinoid receptors [1,3,5].

If the name format is chosen then the names can be added in the text (e.g. Smith et al., 2018 or Smith and Brown, 2015).

### 7. Format of References:

If the name format is chosen, references should be arranged first alphabetically and then further sorted chronologically if necessary. More than one reference from the same author(s) in the same year must be identified by the letters "a", "b", "c", etc. placed after the year of the publication. If the number format is chosen then arrange references by number.
